The year 2023/24 has been a milestone for Insight Institute of Management and Technology (IIMT), marked by significant growth in both financial performance and educational offerings. We increased our revenue by 48%, reaching LKR 56.5 million, and achieved a positive profit before tax of LKR 3.3 million. Additionally, 318 students completed technological courses with a 70% completion rate, and in our business school 185 participants attended six Professional Business Development 3-day Workshops.

This year, we secured LKR 67 million from local donors for infrastructure development and upgrade IT lab. Additionally, the Turkish Cooperation and Coordination Agency (TIKA) provided LKR 22 million worth equipment to modernize our workshops. These advancements have enriched the learning experience and equipped students with advanced resources for future success. These efforts have led to high student satisfaction, strong retention rates, and successful employment outcomes.

Educational Impact

In 2023/24, we expanded our academic offerings with the launch of the Bachelor of Information Technology (BIT) and Foundation in Information Technology (FIT) programs in collaboration with the University of Colombo School of Computing, enrolling 40 students.

We also began offering Diploma and Advanced Diploma courses in collaboration the Distance Learning Center, providing flexible learning opportunities for diverse student needs. Additionally, we introduced NVQ Level 4 in IT programs, further enhancing our vocational training. Over 3019 students successfully completed various programs, including 1,314 in Automobile Mechanics. Our regional expansion into Akurana strengthened our reach, providing quality education and skill development in underserved areas.

Operational Efficiency

In 2023/24, our operational efficiency improved with a 70% completion rate across various programs and significant progress in modernizing our workshops, providing students with state-of-the-art facilities for hands-on learning. These improvements have enhanced both student outcomes and overall learning experiences, better preparing them for the workforce.

Areas for Improvement

Looking ahead, we aim to achieve Quality Management System (QMS) certification ISO 9001:2015, from TVEC and Degree Awarding Status from the Ministry of Higher Education (MHE) to elevate our programs and institutional credibility. Key priorities for the coming year include consolidating our Akurana centre and accelerating our digital transformation to offer more flexible learning options for students.

Career Development Programs

commitment to guiding students toward successful careers continues to be a priority. During this year over 10 career development programs were conducted across the Central, Sabaragamuwa provinces, and Colombo district, reaching more than 2,000 students. These programs offered invaluable insights into career paths and higher opportunities, education helping students make informed decisions about their futures. By collaborating with industry experts and educational institutions. provided students with the tools and guidance they need to succeed in the workforce and further their education.



Focus Areas

In 2025, we plan to focus on expanding our program portfolio by offering NVQ Level 4, 5, and 6 Qualifications in both Automobile and IT courses, providing students with the advanced skills required to meet industry demands. We are also in the process of obtaining Degree Awarding Status from the Ministry of Higher Education (MHE). These new programs will enhance our reputation as an institution offering high-quality academic and technical education and help equip our students with the competencies necessary to excel in their careers.

MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS

Overview

During the year 2023/24, Insight Institute of Management and Technology (IIMT) achieved significant milestones despite challenges in the educational landscape. Our focus remained steadfast on delivering excellence in education, expanding program offerings, and strengthening institutional capacity to meet the demands of a competitive global market.

Financial Performance

IIMT achieved a remarkable 47.80% increase in income compared to the previous year, driven by robust student enrolment growth and the introduction of innovative new courses. This growth was accompanied by a 29.04% increase in profit before tax, demonstrating a strong financial performance.

Despite inflationary pressures and rising infrastructure costs, IIMT maintained a healthy operational margin through strategic cost management and resource optimization. This reflects our unwavering commitment to sustainable growth and operational excellence.

Program Expansion and Academic Excellence

In 2024, IIMT made significant strides in expanding its program offerings. The launch of the NVQ Level 4 ICT course marked a milestone in meeting the growing demand for ICT professionals. Plans are underway to introduce NVQ Level 5 and 6 ICT courses, as well as NVQ Level 4, 5, and 6 programs in Automobile studies, further diversifying our academic portfolio. Additionally, IIMT is preparing to offer NVQ Level 4 and 5 Preschool Teacher Training programs, addressing the need for skilled educators.

This year also emphasized enhancing academic quality and institutional recognition. Efforts to achieve Quality Management System (QMS) certification from the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission (TVEC) are on track. Furthermore, IIMT is actively working toward obtaining Degree Awarding Status by adhering to all Ministry of Higher Education (MHE) standards, reflecting our commitment to excellence and growth.

Student Success and Engagement

Student enrolment at IIMT grew by 18%, driven by effective outreach campaigns, partnerships with local institutions, and the strong reputation of its academic environment. With a completion rate of 70% and an impressive 80% placement rate, IIMT demonstrated its commitment to student success and career readiness. These achievements highlight the relevance of its programs to industry needs and its focus on providing a supportive, student-centric learning experience.

Faculty and Human Capital

Our academic and administrative staff forms the backbone of IIMT's operations. With a faculty retention rate of 95%, we underscore our commitment to professional development through initiatives such as ongoing training programs, workshops.

MANAGEMENT DISCUSSION AND ANALYSIS...

This year, we conducted our own training programs and hosted a specialized training program funded and conducted by TIKA, further enhancing the skills and expertise of our staff.

Infrastructure and Technology Integration

IIMT continued to invest in cutting-edge infrastructure to create an engaging learning environment. The integration of advanced learning management systems and hybrid learning technologies ensured that students and faculty could seamlessly adapt to changing educational paradigms. Key technologies in use include Moodle for course management, a MIS ERP system for accounting, and Koha for library management, all of which support efficient academic and administrative functions.

Sustainability and Community Engagement

As a socially responsible institution, IIMT actively contributed to community welfare through scholarship programs and outreach initiatives. Environmental sustainability was promoted by adopting paperless administrative systems and implementing energy-efficient solutions across campus facilities. Additionally, IIMT received funding from local and international aid agencies to support these initiatives, reinforcing its commitment to both social and environmental responsibility.

Strengths and weaknesses

IIMT's strategic location in Mawanella, near the Colombo-Kandy main road and easily accessible from major cities like Kandy, Gampola, Kurunegala and Kegalle, provides excellent connectivity and a multicultural learning environment. With proximity to major universities fostering academic partnerships, IIMT has built a strong reputation as a quality vocational education provider. Our upgraded IT labs, modern workshops, and expanded infrastructure accommodate more students and support future development. The highly qualified staff, with local and international exposure, enhance the learning experience, while our emphasis on new technologies and diverse educational opportunities positions IIMT as a leader in vocational training and innovation. However, institution faces several weaknesses that hinder its growth and sustainability, including difficulties in recruiting qualified and experienced staff, a lack of collaboration and unethical practices within the sector, and limited external engagement. Insufficient resources for faculty and staff development further weaken its ability to maintain high academic standards, while the absence of on-campus housing facilities for staff and students reduces its appeal. Additionally, minimal interaction with industry limits opportunities for practical, career-oriented learning, and a lack of adequate funding restricts investments in infrastructure and strategic initiatives. Addressing these issues is essential to ensuring the institution's long-term success and competitiveness.

Challenges and Opportunities

IIMT faced several challenges during the fiscal year, including the global economic slowdown, rising costs, sector-specific training needs, lack of knowledge of public on importance of the quality education providers, and unethical service providers in educational industry, difficulties in recruiting qualified staff and high investment cost in upgrdaing in the existing facilities. Despite these obstacles, our agility in addressing these issues through strategic planning and partnerships has positioned us for sustained growth. Looking ahead, opportunities for expansion are abundant. Government support for private-sector participation in education, shorter school education durations increasing the demand for higher education, and a large pool of O/L students Dropping out of the school education system and most A/L students being unable to enter state universities create significant prospects. Additionally, the growing need for IT graduates, lifelong learning programs, reducing foreign exchange outflows through quality local education, and the opportunity to position IIMT as a leading provider of skilled professionals further enhance our growth potential.

INSTITUTIONAL OVERVIEW

In 2008, a dedicated group of social workers, including academics, professionals, and entrepreneurs, came together to establish the Mawanella Institute of Technical Training (MITT) in Mawanella. MITT. initially operated from a rented building, offering TVEC-accredited vocational craft level courses such as Welding, Electrical, Plumbing, and Building Service Technician training.

As MITT gained recognition and success, the group decided to formalize their efforts in 2009 by legally incorporating a trust known as Insight Education Trust (IET). During the same year, IET received invaluable support from philanthropists, enabling the acquisition of Four and a Half acres of land with existing buildings. This pivotal moment allowed IET to conduct its vocational courses on its own premises, ensuring a more comprehensive and sustainable approach to education.

Recognizing the need for a dedicated institution to continue its educational mission, the trustees of IET established a guarantee company named Insight Institute of Management and Technology (IIMT).

Since its inception, IIMT has evolved into a fully-fledged education institute, specializing in NVQ Level 3 & 4 courses. These courses encompass fields such as Automobile Technology, Automobile, Electrical Systems, and Air-Conditioning and Refrigeration Technology, producing approximately 400 highly qualified technicians annually.

In response to the challenges posed by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Board of Directors of IIMT, initiated a remarkable transformation in the last quarter of 2022. This ambitious endeavor aimed to elevate the status of the institute to that of a Technology Campus.

As a Technology Campus, IIMT offers a wide range of academic programs, including Diplomas & Bachelor's degrees, in Information Technology, in addition to its existing vocational training courses.




We recognize the challenges faced by many families who struggle to provide their children with quality education. Approximately half of our students independently finance their education, while the other half requires varying levels of financial assistance.
